All the estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever which Campford Mill, the said corporate company, has, to, in, or upon all and any singular or certain lot and pieces of land situate by way and being in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid bounded and limited as follows to wit: Beginning at Stake 34 two feet from side pedale in line of the present fence and running thence 878 1/20 feet to a Stake 34, thence N 16 1/2 E 100 feet to a Stake 34, thence N 78 E 120 feet to a Stake 34, two feet from present side pedale, thence N 16 1/2 W 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1200 square feet more or less, as will more fully appear by a Plat hereunto attached, with all and singular the buildings and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned and described lot and pieces of land with its appurtenances to said Alexander M. Brewster, Hamlin Beattie, Henry C. Martley, John A. Turner and their successors in office, during the term of this lease to wit, from this date until the first day of March AD 1946, in trust that same shall be held and kept secure under the direction and supervision of said trustees or however place of worship for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church South, according to the rules and description which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by the ministers and preachers of said church at their General Conference; and in further trust and confidence that they shall at all times during the term of this lease keep

such ministers and preachers holding the said church as shall from time to time be duly authorized by the General Conferences of the ministers and preachers of the said Methodist Episcopal Church over whom by the General Conference authorized by the said General Conference preach and expound Gods Holy Word therein; and in further trust and confidence that as often as any one or more of the trustees herein before mentioned shall die or resign, die and in such case it shall be the duty of the stated minister or preacher authorized as aforesaid who shall have the pastoral charge of the members of said church to call a meeting of the remaining trustees as soon as conveniently may be, and when so met the said Minister or Preacher shall proceed to nominate one or more persons to fill the place or places of him or them whose office or offices has or have been vacated as aforesaid, the person or persons so nominated shall be a member of said church and the trustees so assembled shall proceed to elect and by a majority of votes appoint the persons as persons so nominated to fill such vacancy in order to keep up the number of five trustees during the term of this lease, aforesaid, and in further trust and confidence, that the superintendent of said Campford Mill shall designate the time at night after which his occasional services of any description, shall be conducted in said house of worship or upon said lot of land, and the said Campford Mill doth by these presents warrant and defend all and singular the before mentioned and described lot and piece of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the aforesaid trustees and their successors in office for and during the term of this lease aforesaid from the claim or claims of all persons whatsoever residing, when of the original of said corporation, till his aforesaid seat of assembly, heathen, the 14th day of April last
