Duncan all of my right title, interest and estate of, in or to all that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Gre- enville and State aforesaid, on the Spartanburg Road and having the following lines, poles and boundaries, beginning at a Stone 34 on the Spartanburg Road, A.
