sums of money which I am unable at present to
pay in full, and being desirous to convey all my
personal property for the benefit of my creditors,
Now, therefore, know all men by these presents, that
Hattie Wildman, in consideration of the premises
and of five dollars to me paid by Washington D.
Wait of said City, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned
transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant
bargain, sell, assign and set over unto the said Wash-
ington D. Wait all my property and estate of every
kind and description, real, personal and mixed,
and whatsoever styled or denominated, including but
not limited to all my stock in trade in my store on Main
Street in the said City of Greenville, and all my
book accounts, bills, notes, Chars in action, claims
and demands of every kind and nature whatsoever,
so have and to hold the same unto the said Washington
D. Wait, in trust notwithstanding, to sell the said property
and to collect the said amounts, claims and Chars in
action, and then in trust to apply the proceeds ther-
of in the following Manner: 1st To pay all the costs
and charges of these presents, and the lawful ex-
penses of executing the trust hereby created, in
cluding a sum of twenty five dollars to the said Wash-
ington D. Wait for paying the cost of Assignment.

2nd To apply the residue of such proceeds to the pur-
suit of the claims of all the creditors of me, the
said Hattie Wildman, from whom, and without
any preference, when shall occur before the twentieth
day of August A.D. 1885, agree to accept such demand
as dividends as they may severally be willing to
receive the same for payment in full and satisfaction.
