 have granted, bargained, sold and released, and
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said The Summerville and Santee Railroad Com-
 pany, all that certain piece parcel and lot of land sit-
 uate, lying and being in the City and County of Sum-
 merville, in the state aforesaid, near the S. C. Railway de-
 pot, and having the following lines, metes and bounds
