the said premises belonging or in anywise due or appertaining and all the estate right title claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid and of each of them in and to the same and of all other persons rightfully claiming from under or by these or any of them. It have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said A J Mosley and J A McDaniel their heirs and assigns forever.
