Our branch of Musk Creek water of South Yoger River and known as the Benjamin Mill Tract containing sixteen acres more or less bounded by lands of Francis and Morris Turner Lafayette and William Tilly being the same tract which was conveyed to me and Melborne Garnell and President Davis Garnell by deed of John Garnell Executed the 23rd of December 1874 and Recorded in the Office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for Greenville County in said State Book L G Page 799. Also a certain tract land known as the Hudson place adjoining the Mill tract above described conveyed to me and Melborne Garnell and President Davis Garnell by John Holley containing fifty seven acres more or less and bounded by lands of Robert Helman Melborne Garnell and others and more fully described in a deed of John Holley to me and Melborne Garnell and President Davis Garnell in which I own one half interest which I hereby convey to the said Mary Garnell Together with all and singular the Rights Members and appurtenances and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mary Garnell her Heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby

myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary Garnell her Heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs and against every person who or ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
