receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
granted, bargained, sold, released and by
these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Thompson W. Carle a certain piece
parcel or tract of land lying and being in the

State and County of said, bounded by lands of J. J. Douthitt
Estate of W. A. Townes dec'd, Thomas Childs and others, con-
taining Thirty two Acres, more or less, beginning at a stone
3x6m in the fork of the branch, thence S 17 1/4 E 3.62 to a stone 3x
6m, thence N 82 1/4 E 4.75 to a stone 3x by a chestnut, thence S 17 1/4 E

Heirs and Assigns against and on Heirs and every
other person lawfully claiming, or to claim the same
