Wesley Holliday, all that certain parcel of land situate in Greenville Co. S.C. on Saluda River, containing Fifteen and 1/2 Acres more or less, beginning at a stake 3x, thence S 80 1/4 W 57.30 to a stake 3x on Saluda River, thence down the meandering of said river to a stake 3x, thence N 79 1/4 E. 56.80 to a stake 3x, thence S 32 1/4 W 2.07 to the beginning corner.
