Southern (School Trustees) in the State of aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. P. Goodwin, A. W. Humphreys and W. D. Southern, as School Trustees, and their successors in office, a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being situate in Greenville County in Saluda Township School District No. 15, on the west side of the North Saluda River and on the north side of the road now leading from Marietta to Dalys bridge beginning at a corner of Francis Drummell's land, a Rock 3x near a big red oak on the north side of the road and runs with her line N 57 1/2 E 108 chains to a Rock 12x, thence South 6° E 102 links to a corner 3x on the south side of the road, thence due west across the road 2 chains to Rock 3x, thence N 6 1/2 W 250 chains to Rock 3x, thence East one chain to corner Rock in Francis Drummell's line thence with said line S 6° E 200 chains to beginning of corner.
