 Do Assignment. County of Greenville.  
 Geo. W. Drisley. This Indenture made the 20<sup>th</sup> day of  
 May A.D. 1886, between Mrs. V. V. Pool, doing business as  
 a Retail Liquor Dealer in the City of Greenville Co.,  
 through her Agent, M. R. Pool, party of the first part  
 and Geo. W. Drisley party of the second part, wit-  
 nesseth; That whereas the said Mrs. V. V. Pool is indebted  
 to divers persons and in various sums of money,  
 which by reason of misfortune she is unable to pay  
 in full: And whereas the said Mrs. V. V. Pool is de-  
 sirous of providing as best she can for the payment  
 of said debts, by an assignment of all her property  
 and effects for that purpose. Now therefore in consid-  
 eration of the premises and the sum of one dollar to her  
 in hand paid by the said Geo. W. Drisley, at and be-  
 fore the execution of these presents he recollecting  
 is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold  
 and assigned and set out, and by these presents do  
 grant, bargain, sell and assign all and over into  
 the said Geo. W. Drisley his heirs, executors, admis-  
 trators and assigns, all the same

wares, merchandise, notes, accounts, claims, demands, and prop-  
 erty of every kind and description, real, personal and mixed  
 belonging to the said Mrs. V. V. Pool, saving and excepting  
 such property as is by Law to her exempt from levy and  
 sale under execution. To have and to hold the same, and  
 every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances  
 unto the said Geo. W. Drisley, his heirs, executors, adminis-  
 trators, and assigns forever. In trust nevertheless, and  
 to and for the uses, interests and purposes following  
 that is to say: First, To take possession of the said prop-  
 erty hereby assigned, and to sell and dispose of  
 the same with all reasonable diligence, at public or  
 private sale as he may deem most beneficial  
 to the interests of all concerned, and convert the same  
 into cash: also to collect as soon as possible, such  
 debts and demands, hereby assigned, as may be  
 collectible, and with and out of the proceeds of such  
 sales and collections: Secondly, To pay all just and  
 reasonable costs and expenses in the making of  
 this assignment and in carrying into effect the  
 trusts hereby created, including a Commiss fee of  
 Fifty Dollars to P. H. Cooke, atty. together with the lawful  
 commissions of the said Geo. W. Drisley, for his services  
 in executing said trusts, and the commissions of  
 any agent or agents, who may be appointed by the creditor  
 to act with the said Geo. W. Drisley. Thirdly, after paying  
 such expenses, commissions and fee, the said Geo.  
 W. Drisley shall out of the residue of said monies  
 pay all debts due by the said assignor, to any person  
 or persons who shall within ninety days after the  
 date of these presents, accept the terms of this assign-  
 ment, and execute to the said assignor a release  
 or releases in full of the amounts of their respective  
 demands, said releasing creditors to be paid in  
 full if there be sufficient of said monies for that  
 purpose, otherwise to be paid ratably and in pro-  
 portion to their respective claims. Fourthly, if there  
 be any of said monies remaining after fully  
 paying and discharging the demands of said  
 releasing creditors, the said Geo. W. Drisley shall dis-  
 tribute the same among all the creditors of the said  
 assignor, both nobly, and in proportion to amounts
