have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released

by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
said The Greenville and Laurens Railroad Company all those
two certain pieces parcels and lots of land, adjoining,
each other and now constituting one, situate lying
and being in said County and State on least East
of Main Street in the City of Greenville and having the
following lines meters and bounds, to-wit: No. 1, Beginning
at a stake on Court Street, Henry Pullen's corner
and running thence N. 72 1/2 W. 79 links to a stake 3 x 3 x
on said Court Street, thence S. 2 1/2 W. 3.18 chs. to a stake 3 x 3 x
m. m. at the Park fence, thence S. 72 1/2 E. 85 1/2 links to a stake
3 x 3 x m. at said Park fence, thence S. 33 1/2 E. 3.18 chs. to the begin-
ning on Court Street 3 x 3 x m. No. 2, adjoining the above
