

See Deed from Chilesen Huff & C. W. Huff Trustees in Book A.A. page 252

and containing twelve hundred acres more or less upon certain tracts, the last of said tracts being to convey said lands to his three sons, James William Huff, Augustus Huff and Franklin Lafayette Huff of record and discharged from the trust, or in case of the death of either or all of them under twenty one years of age, then to convey said land to his or their heirs all of which will more fully appear by reference to said deed which is recorded in Book A.A. page 252 of the Office of the Register of Meigs conveyance for Greenwell County, and whereas all of the trusts of said deed have been fully executed save that part thereof relating to the conveyance, which has been executed only in part, the said James William Huff, Augustus Huff and Franklin Lafayette Huff having long since attained their majority and gone into possession of said land and divided the same amongst themselves, but no deed has been made to the said Franklin Lafayette Huff for his part of said land by either the said James William Huff or the said Augustus Huff or myself as trustee, although the said Augustus Huff has received a deed to his part of said land as partitioned and the said James William Huff has disposed of his part, now therefore know all men by these presents that I, the said Paschal D. Huff, in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the power conferred upon me by the deed from Chilesen Huff hereinbefore mentioned, and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars hereby acknowledged to be paid to me by the said Franklin Lafayette Huff, have granted, bargained, sold and released and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Franklin Lafayette Huff all that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being on Rock Creek in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Augustus Huff, Thomas Thomson and others and having the following lines, metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake corner in Rock Creek at the old Bridge Place, and running thence S 43 1/2 E 175 to a bend in the old road, thence S 36 E 273 to another bend, thence S 43 E 755 to another bend, thence S 36 1/2 E 200 to another bend, thence S 49 1/2 E 69 to another bend, thence S 27 1/2 E 43 to another bend at the

of the old road with another road, thence with the last road S 49 E 238 to a bend, thence S 57 1/2 E 300, thence S 65 1/2 E 294 to a bend thence S 69 E 700 to a bend, thence S 74 E 226 to a stone corner in road, thence S 43 E 327.75 to a Maple 3 x n, thence with a small branch to a stone 3 x n, thence N 29 E 2317 to a stone 3 x n (A.C. gone) on the Reely Ferry Road, thence with said Road N 15 W 12.80 to a stone 3 x, thence N 65 W 35.20 to a R.C. 3 x, thence N 28 E 27.10 to a stone 3 x, thence N 2 1/4 E 1.70 to a stone 3 x 0, thence N 70 E 4.08 to a stone 3 x 0, thence N 1 1/2 W 3.42 to a stone 3 x 0, thence N 46 1/2 W 22.00 to a corner in Rock Creek below three Milkings and thence with the meanders of said creek to the beginning, containing three hundred and seventy four Acre more or less and being that part of said Twelve hundred acre tract which fell to the said Franklin Lafayette Huff upon the division aforesaid, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Franklin Lafayette Huff his heirs and assigns forever. Know all men by these presents that we the within mentioned James William Huff and Augustus Huff do hereby acknowledge and ratify and confirm the partition of land between ourselves and said Franklin Lafayette Huff as mentioned in the within deed, and in consideration thereof and of one dollar paid us by said Franklin Lafayette Huff, we and each of us do hereby renounce release and forever relinquish unto the said Franklin Lafayette Huff all of our right, title interest and estate of us, or to all and singular the premises within described, to have and to hold the same unto the said Franklin Lafayette Huff his heirs and assigns forever.
