McCullough a tract of land containing Eighty five and one third acres be the same more or less situated in State and County aforesaid and described as follows Beginning on a stone or thereabouts 15.50 chains to a wh. or near spring thence down the meanderings of said spring branch to a dog wood or thereabouts thence S. 88 W. 31.17 chains to a stone or thereabouts thence N. 29 W. E. 34.67 chains to a stone or thereabouts thence N. 63 W. E. 14.15 chains to a Walnut or thereabouts thence S. 73 E. 8.62 chains to the beginning bounded by lands of Benjamin Miller Pitt McCloy James S. French and Mrs. Josiah White above described land being the land devised to Josiah White by James McCullough 7th of May 1861 together with all and singular the rights and hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
