 in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof
 is here by acknowledged) have granted, bargained
 sold and released and by these Presents do
 Grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
 Walter S. Gray and Shadens T. Ellison all those
 pieces, parcels and tracts of land described
 as follows, to wit: all that piece, parcel and
 of land situate, lying and being in the State
 and County aforesaid, containing one hundred
 and forty seven acres, more or less, being
 a part of the C. Vincent tract of land and
 more fully described in a deed made to
 me by Reuben Dockins and recorded in the Office
 of the Register of Mense Conveyance of said County
 in Book S. C. page 64 and bounded by lands
 of Waddy Jordan, Fanny Chapman, Lindy
 Chapman and Estate of G. W. Holliday and
