

nevertheless to, for and upon the following trusts
 that is to say: In trust for a Baptist Church of said
 City, County and State now in process of organiza-
 tion, under the direction of said Rev. P. Brown, and
 in trust further upon the organization of said Church
 to execute such deed or declare such trust in re-
 gard to said lands, as said Church may by resolu-
 tion duly adopted direct. And in case of the death
 of one or more of said Trustees the said Church shall
 have full power to appoint others to fill the vacancies
 or vacancies, and those so appointed shall have
 all the powers conferred upon the Trustees hereby
 appointed. Such appointments to be made by reso-
 lution of the Church. And I do hereby bind myself
 my Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, to war-
 rant and forever defend all and singular of
 the said premises unto the said Anderson
 Jones, G. G. Harris and Rev. P. Brown their succe-
 sors in office Heirs, and Assigns, against myself
 and my Heirs, and against every person who
 shall lawfully claim, or to claim the same
 or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal
 this 17th day of October in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and eighty four
 and in the one hundred and ninth year of
 the Sovereignty and Independence of the United
 States of America.
