Williams, a citizen in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jno S. Williams all that piece of land or tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid about twelve miles from Greenville S.C., sloping waters to the southward on the bank of Little Bishop's Creek, bounded on the east by Morgan Brown and others. It being part of a tract conveyed to me by Mrs. Lizzie Bowling in a deed bearing date March 11th, 1857, it contains forty-two and one tenth acres (42 1/10 ac.) The same, more or less, and runs as follows: Beginning at a stone corner on the main bank and run thence N 88° E 90° to a stone, thence S 26° E 7.90 to a stone in center of the mill road, thence along said road N 88° E 84.60 to a bend in the road thence S 88° E 4.80 to a stone, thence S 46° E 6.30 to White O. thence S 48° E 3.10 to a stone, thence S 60° E 2.80 to a stone, thence S 24° E 3.50 to a stone, thence S 24° E 2.25 to a stone in the creek, thence down the creek to a stone, thence by a line to a rock, then to a log, then to a stone, thence S 60° E 2.80 to a stone, thence N 30° W 8.60 to a small spruce on the branch, thence up the branch of the stream to a white oak stump, thence N 38° E 9.00 to the beginning stone corner.
