the City of Greenville, S.C. on the Ashville Road on lands
marked by George Gunther (G. G.) Bound by lands of Mr.
Taylor, Mr. C. R. King, Mr. Wright and others, containing
one and one-half acres, to-wit, the same more or less
as being as it is enclosed to us by Isabella J. Taylor by a
deed bearing date Nov 22nd, 1890 and runs as follows: Beginning
at a corner in the Ashville Road and running thence N 45° W 56.11;
to a stone fence post 8 1/2 rods to the intersection of a small branch with
the Gunther Fork Branch, thence down the branch to a corner with
