Stone Rivers all that parcel of land lying and being in the City of Greenville County and State of South Carolina on the North side of Stone Avenue between Bowes and Wilson Street and adjoining lots, all the described real property formerly owned by Mrs. Eugenia A. Stone and David Dillards and having the following boundaries and surveys to wit: Beginning at a stake on Stone Avenue corner of Dillards lot thence with Stone Avenue 184 ft E 13° feet one hundred and thirty one feet to a stake. Thence N 54° E 2. (Two Hundred) feet to a stake. Thence N 54° E 131 (One Hundred and thirty one) feet to a stake corner of Dillards lot corner S 54° W 100 (Two Hundred) feet to beginning corner and east boundary as lot No 4 Map 4 of the Stone Lands made by Mr. Smith.
