all that, say or parcel of land, situate in the County of State aforesaid, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, containing twenty-two hundredths ( $\frac{22}{100}$ ) of an acre, more or less, situate in the division of the real estate of W. A. Callaway, deceased, as lot no. 3 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the corner of said street; thence S. 13 1/2° W. along said street 155 feet; thence S. 71 1/2° E. 141 feet; thence N. 20 1/4° W. 190 feet to the beginning.
