I, *D.P. Verrier*, MASTER IN AND FOR THE COUNTY AFORESAID, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *Mary T. Garrison*,

on or about the *9th* day of *November*,
eighteen hundred and *ninety three* exhibited her
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

demanding judgment in relation to the *real estate* hereinafter mentioned and
described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *twelfth*
day of *November*, 1893, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a *decree*
of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said *real estate*
hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by *D.P. Verrier*, Master,
in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said *decree*
as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; and the said Master, after having duly advertised the said

D.P. Verrier, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration
of the sum of *nine hundred and fifty* Dollars to me paid by the said

John King, Stephen King and Joseph King,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents DO
GRANT, bargain, sell, and release unto the said

John King, Stephen King and Joseph King, all their
log or parcel of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, on *Chadwell Street*,
in the City of *Greenville*, known in the division of the real estate of *Thomas J. Turner*,
deceased, as lot No. 1. Beginning at an iron pin on said street, and running thence *N. 70 1/2*
W. 64 feet to a stake; thence *N. 19 1/2 W. 101 feet* to a stake; thence *S. 70 1/2 W. 64 feet* to an alley
iron pin - thence *S. 19 1/2 E. 101 feet* to the beginning corner. See files of *J. N. Southern, D.S.*
