Rambo, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said R.L. Rambo Lot No 430 of Springwood Cemetery, having the following dimensions to wit; 11 by 12 feet, for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose of aforesaid and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor and all provisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force or which may hereafter be passed relating to said cemetery and burial of the dead therein.

Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said R.L. Rambo his heirs and assigns forever subject however to the limitations and conditions herein before imposed, and it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said R.L. Rambo, Heirs and assigns against itself and its successors in office against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
