Executor Estate Rebecca G Jones deceased paid by the said
party of the second part, has granted bargained sold
and released and by these Presents does grant forgive
sell and release unto the said party of the second part
him and his heirs and assigns forever all the
estate right title interest property possession claim
and demand whatsoever both in law and equity
which the said Testator had at the time of his
decease, and which the said party of the first part
has by virtue of the said last will and Testament
of Mrs Rebecca G Jones deceased of in and to all
that house and lot situated on the west side of
Buncombe Street in the City of Greenville State
and County aforesaid fronting on said
Buncombe Street Ninety seven feet and six
inches and extending west two hundred and
nine feet and five inches more or less, and
adjoining the residence of S P Burdage
and the lot of D W Ebsugh being a part of
the real estate owned by Mrs Rebecca G
Jones at the time of her decease,
