Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said The First Baptist Church, heirs and assigns forever, subject however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed. And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said The First Baptist Church heirs and assigns against itself and its successors in office and against any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
