 To: Deed } The State of South Carolina,
 Theodore C Stone } Know all men by these presents, that
 whereas, in the month of November 1894, the late Eugenia A
 Stone, of the city of Greenville, in the State of aforesaid, did
 convey by a certain deed in writing a certain lot of land
 in said City to Theodore C Stone, which said lot lies on
 the east side of Rutherford Street, and contains four acres
 more or less, and said deed of conveyance is recorded
 in the office of Register of Messrs Conveyance for
 Greenville County, in Book B B B page 238.

And whereas the said Theodore C Stone duly entered
 upon the said lot as owner thereof, under said deed, in
 November 1894, and has since occupied, owned and
 managed the same, and a dwelling house has been
 erected there on.

And whereas, the description in said deed being
 indefinite, it is desired to mark the boundaries of the
 said lot as it was originally conveyed to said Theodore
 C Stone, and a permanent corner having been heretofore
 established and marked by a stone in the east line of
 Rutherford Street, said corner has this day been further
 marked by an iron pin and said pin is the true south
 west corner of the said lot of said Theodore C Stone and
 is also in the line of a proposed Street.

Now therefore, I Floride L. Stone, in consideration
 of the premises and to the end that the boundaries of the
 said lot may be finally and permanently fixed, and
 in the further consideration of One Dollar, to me
 in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
 by Theodore C Stone (the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
 release unto the said Theodore C Stone, all that certain
 parcel or lot of land on Rutherford Street in said City,
 beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Ruther-
 ford Street, and a proposed street near the edge of the
 present grove in front of my residence, and running
 thence with the east side of Rutherford Street in a westerly
 direction 420 feet to a corner, thence at right angles to
 said Street in an easterly direction 110 feet to a corner,
 thence in a southerly direction and a distance of 110 feet
 to the said Street, thence in an easterly direction

proposed street to the beginning corner, being the lot heretofore
 conveyed, as aforesaid to the said Theodore C Stone,
 Together with all and singular the rights member hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
 incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
 before mentioned unto the said Theodore C Stone his heirs
 and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said Theodore C Stone
 his heirs and assigns, against myself, and my heirs lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,
 Witness my hand and seal this twenty-sixth day of September
 in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred, and
 in the one hundred and twenty-fifth year of the sovereignty
 and Independence of the United States of America,
