H. Southern and E. M. Hunt Surveyors, on 28 day of June 1898, situating and being in Cleveland Township in the State and County aforesaid on the west side of the Middle Fork of Saluda River to wit: lot No. 1 containing four acres more or less, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake 4 m on the west bank of said river opposite the mouth of Little Creek, then N 64 1/2 W 3.80 ch, to stake 4 whence N 42 1/2 W 4.00 ch, to stake 4 whence S 52 1/2 E 4.70 ch, to stake 4 whence S 21 1/2 W 4.50 ch to Birch 34 m on bank of said river.
