and before the sealing of these presents by Isaac Ballou of Greenville County in the State
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said Isaac Ballou, All of the following described parcels or pieces of land
situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina
to wit, on the waters of South Pacolet River, thence to a Spanish Oak on the old line
thence nearly south with the Mill road to a rock on the conditional line, thence to the
conditional line to the beginning rock corner, containing 26 acres more or less
being a part of the old tract of land laid off by Isaac Ballou to Isaac Ballou his heirs
the same tract deeded to Nancy Harrison by Isaac Ballou and recorded the 11th
of March 1880 in Book K, page 374, on the head waters of South Pacolet River
beginning on a Sourwood tree, a conditional corner on the old line, thence with the
said line to the double Chestnut tree, thence North eastward to a Dogwood tree, thence
Northwest to a Spanish oak, thence Westward a few paces to a conditional stone corner
thence down the branch a conditional line Southward to a pine near the church then
Westward to a Black gum on the big branch, thence with said branch to a stone corner at the
fork of the branch, thence up the branch to a Maple at the head of the branch, thence to the big
