McBrayer, all that piece parcel and lot of land, containing nine and one half 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less, situate in the County and State aforesaid three miles from Greenville Court House on the Greenville & Columbia Railroad and Brushy Creek branch, watered by Needy River, bounded by lands of J.M. Benton, Sam Williamson, E. Payne and others and having such meles and bounds and courses and descriptions as is represented by a plat of the same made by M. Southern the 7th day of January 1876, being the same tract conveyed by John Williamson to Maurice Byrum our witnesseth on the 17th day of January 1876,

McBrayer his Heirs, and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
