Goodwin, of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Greenville Gas and Electric Light and Power Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville Gas and Electric Light and Power Company, All that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the fourth ward, of the City of Greenville and State aforesaid. Beginning at an iron pin near a post oak on the North side of Broad Street, thence N. 18° E. 134 feet to a stake corner thence S. 71° E. 128 feet to a stake N. E. thence S. 18° E. 134 feet to a stake or fence post on said Broad Street, thence along said Broad Street to the beginning corner containing 17152 square feet more or less, bounded by lots of Dower, Thos. Howell and others being the same lot conveyed to me by Jennie L. Goodwin by deed dated 5 day of January A. D. 1891, and recorded R. M. C. office Book X. K. Judge 3461

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville Gas and Electric Light and Power Company, its successors, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Greenville Gas and Electric Light and Power Company, its successors, Heirs and Assigns against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
