whereas by Act of Genl Assembly, of the State of South Carolina
incorporating the city of Greenville, approved Decr 29 A.D. 1880, it is
provided that the City Council of Greenville shall have power to entitle
the payment of certain taxes levied under the authority of said Act against
the property of defaulter to the same extent and in the same manner as
is now or may hereafter be provided by law for the collection of State
and County taxes, except that previous to enacting the payment of taxes
shall be issued under the seal of the corporation by the Clerk thereof,
directed by the City of Greenville, or any other officer designated by them for
that purpose; And whereas on the 15th day of April 1897, I.D.O. McDaniel
Clerk & Treasurer of the City Council of Greenville, under his hand and the
corporate seal, issued his warrant of execution against the property of
Abraham Plumber (dead), a copy of which is hereto attached and
whereas after due advertisement the premises hereinbefore mentioned were
thence sold to J.C. Payne for the sum of Thirty Dollars, he being at that
price the highest bidder and whereas he did comply with the terms of sale,
now therefore I.D.O. Martin, special tax collector for the City Council
of Greenville, being duly authorized by them to do so, is constituted
of the premises, and in the further consideration of the sum of Thirty Dollars,
good & lawful money of the United States of America to me in hand paid
