Paynter, and their successors, in Office for said trust, that they & their friends have already built a house to worship in, & have named it Lebanon, for the use and benefit of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in the United States of America, according to the rules, discipline, which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by the Ministers, and friends, of the said Church, at their General Conference in the United States of America, and further trust & confidence that they shall at all times, for ever hereafter, permit such preachers, as Ministers of the said Methodist Episcopal Church, or shall from time to time, duly authorized by the General Conferences of the Ministers, and Preachers, of the said Methodist Episcopal Church, or by the annual conference authorized by the General Conferences to preach and expound God's word therein, and in further trust, & confidence, that as often as any one or more of the Trustees herein before mentioned, shall cease to be a member or member of said Church according to the rule and discipline of the same, then in such case, it shall be the duty of the Statuary Minister or Preacher, (entituled), who shall have the post and charge of the members, of said Church, to call a meeting of the remaining Trustees, & upon so doing, may do & observe, meet the said Minister or Preacher, shall proceed to nominate one or more persons to fill the place or places of him or them whose office or office has so been vacated, & if no person or persons so nominated, shall have been one year member or member of the said Church, immediately preceding such nomination, and be at least twenty one years of age, and the said Trustees so assembled, shall proceed to elect & by voting of votes, appoint the person or persons so nominated, to fill such vacancies, as vacancies, in order to keep up the number of nine Trustees, or more, and in case of an equal number of votes, for & against the nomination, the Statuary Minister or Preacher, shall have the casting vote. Provided nevertheless, that if the said Trustees, or any one of them, shall, for want of sufficient, or other advancement, or other advance any sum of money or sums, or value, or account, of said sum promised, by the said trustee, or his successor, he shall be obliged to pay the said sum of money, by over majority of them, shall be authority to cause said sum or sums of money by a mortgage, and the premises, not paying said sum or sums of money, to the parties aforesaid, who had a right of the execution attacking their service, on the 1st day of January, of the money due, or not paid to the said trustees, or their successors, within one year after such sum or sums, and which shall take place to said trustees, or their successors, after paying the debt, and other expenses, which are due from the money owing from and to all, shall, except the sum of the money paid, be paid, all, in the hands of the Standard & Poor's, of the
