KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Ducilla Boozer, of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the Ten Dollars to me paid by the Paris Mountain Water Company, a Corporation organized under the Laws of and doing business in the State aforesaid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in the further consideration of the privileges of getting water on my place herein-after mentioned from time-to-time the pipes of said Water Company on as reasonable terms as the same is furnished to other persons, have granted bargain and sold and do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto the said PARIS MOUNTAIN WATER COMPANY, its Successors and Assigns a Right of Way over my tract of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, and State aforesaid adjoining lands of Fannie E. Gwyn, Alrabe PR. & others for the purpose of laying their pipes or conduits, to conduct water from or near Paris Mountain in said County, to the City of Greenville, S.C. with the privilege of entering upon the same and making such excavations, fills and levels as may be requisite and the privilege of laying such other pipes or conduits, as may from time to time be necessary, such pipes or conduits to be approximately located along the line of present pipe of the Paris Mountain Water Company, running about 200 feet from the south-west corner of the lot to the City of Greenville, S.C. and all other rights and privileges for the purpose aforesaid unto the said Paris Mountain Water Company, its Successors and Assigns forever.

Know all men by these presents, that the Charleston and Western Carolina Railway Company, a corporation duly chartered under and by the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by George W. Taylor, of Greenville, South Carolina, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Taylor, all those three blocks of land situated in the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid adjoining the water and

freight depot of the Southern Railway Company, and described as follows:

First block: Beginning on an iron pin corner Washington Street and Right of way of said Southern Railway Company, near the passenger station, and running thence N. 3° 10' W. three hundred and seven feet to a stake corner on Maple Street; thence with said street N. 86° 55' E. one hundred and twenty feet to corner on Cooke Street; thence S. 3° 10' E. three hundred and forty one and one half feet to corner on Mulberry Street; thence with said street S. 63° 45' W. sixty-three and one half feet to corner on Washington Street; thence along said street N. 48° 21' W. ninety-three and ten-twelfths feet to the beginning corner. Same lots conveyed by Gower & Symmes, Trustees, part to H. C. Markley, who conveyed it to H. J. Shumate; and part to Greer, Randall & Cox; by them to Milton Cox; by him to A. C. Freeman; by her to F. C. Gower; by him and A. C. Freeman to H. J. Shumate, and by her, both lots, to the Greenville & Laurens Railroad Company.

Second block: Beginning on corner on Maple Street and property of the Southern Railway, and running thence N. 3° 10' W. three hundred and fifteen feet to corner on Ashe Street; thence along Ashe Street N. 86° 55' E. one hundred and twenty feet to corner on Cooke Street; thence along Cooke Street S. 3° 10' E. three hundred and fifteen feet to a corner on Maple Street; thence along Maple Street S. 86° 55' W. one hundred and twenty feet to beginning corner. Same lots conveyed by Gower & Symmes, Trustees, in five parts to H. J. Shumate, H. J. Shumate, Milton Cox, W. H. Perry and Greer, Randall & Cox; W. H. and H. J. Shumate conveyed to the Greenville & Laurens Railroad Company; Greer, Randall & Cox to Milton Cox; he one lot to M. C. Williams, and she to the Greenville & Laurens Railroad Company; Milton Cox conveyed another lot to H. C. Williams and he to the Greenville & Laurens Railroad Company; W. H. Perry conveyed to Freeman & Wright, they to A. C. Freeman, and she to the Greenville & Laurens Railroad Company.
