nine hundred and three between D.A. Anders of the county of Transylvania and State of North  
Carolina, of the first part, and G.W. Wilson, Ira G. Ledbetter and W.P. Bishop of the county of  
Transylvania and State of North Carolina, of the second part,

WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the  
sum of Two Hundred Fifteen Dollars, in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the re-  
ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has Bargained, and Sold, Conveyed and Confirmed, and by these  
presents doth bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said parties of the second part, their  
heirs and assigns, FOREVER all the following described piece parcel of land lying and being in  
the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina and known and designated as follows, viz:  
lying on the waters of Mathers Creek, and South Saluda River, and known as the Dismal land, ad-  
joining lands of Gingard & others. Beginning on a water oak 3-xn and runs North 65 E. 41.50  
to a W.O. 3x thence North 16 W.66 to a stake 3xthence North 45 W.68 to a stake, thence South  
15° W.102 to a stake, thence 62 E.65 to a Chestnut oak, 3n-thence to the beginning, containing  
704 acres more or less, being the same land granted to W.A. Bishop and D.A. Anders Grant dated  
29 day of March 1860 by the State of South Carolina, Recorded in book D, page 281 in Auditor
