on the north side of lands belonging to Jno. M. Miller, and hath following courses, Meats
and bounds, to-wit:—

Beginning at a stone twenty feet from J. M. Millers line on north side
of Proposed Street twenty feet wide, running between Millers line and the lot herein des-
cribed and runs thence N. 64 W. 5.00 chs. with a parallel line to Millers line on north
side of proposed new street to a stone in field N. M. thence due north 9.80 chs. to a stone
N. M. thence due east 5.00 chs. to a stone N. M. thence due south 10.28 chs. to the begin-
