Shumate, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the city and county of Greenville, in the state before said: - Comprising at an iron pin on Washington Street, where it intersects the railroad purchase, thence N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. two hundred and sixty-three (263) feet, to a stake on what is known by Dickson's Plat, dated September 1873, as lot No. 2, thence N. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. one hundred and twenty (20) feet, to a stake on Back Street, thence S. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. two hundred and fifty-eight (258) feet, to a stake, thence S. 56 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. sixty-three and one-half (63 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet, to a stake on Washington Street, thence along said street, ninety-one and one-half (91 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet, to the beginning pin.
