That, furthermore, they have complied with all the requirements of the Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina, of 1902, and all Acts or parts of Acts amendatory thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. T. Cantt, Secretary of State, by virtue of authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purpose indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mense Conveyance in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

Wilkins, of the City and County of Greenville and of the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid by Paris Mountain Water Company, a corporation of the State of South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the Privilege of obtaining water on our property, hereinafter mentioned, from the pipes of the said Paris Mountain Water Company on as reasonable terms as the said Company furnishes water to others, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Paris Mountain Water Co., its successors and assigns a right of way over our certain tract or parcel of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville and State aforesaid, for the purposes of laying its pipes or water-mains to conduct water from or near Paris Mountain, in said County of Greenville, to the City of Greenville, with the privilege of entering upon such land and making such excavations, fills or levels as may be necessary, and with the further privilege of laying such pipes or water-mains as may be necessary and of making such repairs as may from time to time be considered expedient or advisable by said Company. Such pipes or water-mains shall be located as follows: Beginning at a point at the intersection of Hammett and Pinkney streets and running across the old fair ground property in a Direct line S. 68. 1/2 E. about 432 feet to the present location of the highest water-main of the said Company.
