Farr proposes to organize a Corporation to be known as Saluda River Power Company, for the purpose of developing the power of Saluda River by erecting and maintaining a dam or dams across Saluda River at or near a certain point(s) to be hereafter located by said A.G. Furman or his assignees), on the lands of R.A. Means in Greenville and Pickens Counties to the height of thirty-nine feet above low-water. And, whereas, I am the owner of certain lands lying on, or near said River, which will be affected more or less, by the pond of back-water by said dam or dams.
