Whereas Mrs Anna Elizabeth Hayden or about the twenty seventh day of May A.D.1905, commenced an action in the court of common pleas for said state and county against Hiram B. Mitchell, Rosa V.ertner Thweatt, Bessie Elizabeth Duke, Anna May Baker, Mattie Cornelius Cooper, Augustus Howe Hayden, William Augustus Hayden and Margerite Hayden, praying for the sale of the lot of land hereinbefore described and the expenditure of the proceeds of such sale in making improvements on other real estate; and whereas a decree was rendered in said cause by the honorable Geo. E. Prince presiding Judge on the seventeenth day of June A.D.1905, authorizing and requiring the said Hiram B. Mitchell, as trustee for the said Anna Elizabeth Hayden to execute and deliver unto W.T.Hudson and W.Austin Hudson a deed of Conveyance in fee simple for said land, upon payment of sum of Six Hundred and Twenty five Dollars, less the cost and expenses of said action (which costs and expenses have been taxed at seventy five and 25/100 dollars the said net proceeds to be expended by said trustee as in said decree provided; Now, therefore know all men by these presents that I, Hiram B. Mitchell of Columbia, in the County of Richland and State of South Carolina, as trustee of the said Anna Elizabeth Hayden, in obedience to the said decree and in consideration of the said net sum of Six hundred and forty nine and 75/100 dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said W.T.Hudson and W.A.Hudson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.T.Hudson and W.Austin Hudson, All that certain lot, piece or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in the third ward of the city of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat thereof prepared by J.H. McCollough civil engineer bearing date June 10, 1905 to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the north east corner of Jones Street and Oscar street and running thence S.53 E. along said Oscar Street one hundred one forty two (142) feet and six (6) inches to an iron pin on corner of Dr. E.W. Carpenter's lot; thence along Dr. Carpenter's line N.34°E. one hundred and forty two 142 feet to an iron pin on the corner of Mrs Anna E. Hayden's lot; thence along line of her said lot N.50°W. one hundred and twenty three (123) feet and six (6) inches to an iron pin on Jones Street which iron pin is exactly Two hundred and fifty five (255) feet from the corner of Jones and Washington Street; thence along said Jones Street S.41°W. one hundred and forty nine (149) feet and six (6) inches to the beginning corner; this being a portion of the lot of land conveyed by the City Warehouse Company to the late Harriet Mitchell, by deed bearing date April 15, 1879, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, on April 21, 1879, in deed Book "J.J." at page 456, the said Harriet Mitchell having departed this life leaving of full force and effect her last will and testament bearing date the ninth day of March 1881 and duly admitted to probate by the appropriate court for Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on the twenty sixth day of May 1887, whereby she devolved the said lot of land to me the said Hiram B. Mitchell, in trust for Anna Elizabeth Hayden;

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in any way incident thereto, and to have and to hold all and singular the premises above described and the right of way thereon, and the same to their heirs and assigns forever.
