Harris the lesser on the fiest part, and Oregon Lumber Company the lessee on the second part, Witnesseth, that the said Mrs. M.H. and Mrs. M.C. Harris have granted and released, and by these presents deth Grant, and lease, unto the said Oregon Lumber Company the one story brick ware-house + 108 E. McBee Avenue, Greenville, S.C. with the let adjaining to Fall's Street en the East, and from MeBee Avenue, to alley way; also the one story frame building ,on the Cerner McBee Avenue ,and Fall Street known as Cleveland Ware-house with let new used as Lumber yard with all the appurtenances thereunte belonging; To Have and to hold, the said premises unto the said Oregon Lumber Company Executors, Administrators and Assings, for the full term of Five (5) years commencing on the first day ef October, 1905, and ending on the First Ist., day of October 1910 yielding and paying at the rate of Six Hundred (600.00) Dellars per year for the first two years ,and Six hundred and Fifty (\$650.00) Dellars for the last three years of this Lease pe r ammin, payable menthly at the end of each menth, The Lessers have the right to with-draw the let adjoining ware-house, used as a Lumber yard, and described above, should they wish to build on, or sell same, er, impreve in any way and case they should do so the rent of the premises shall be reduced one hundred dellars per annum, during the Balance of the term of this Lease after with-grawing said let. And the said Lessee, for and in consideration of the above letter premises, doth covenant and agree to pay to the said Lesser, the above stipulated rent, in the manner herein required and it is further agreed, that unless one months notice in writting, be given previous to the expiration of the period agrein specified by the lesser, to the lessee, of their desire to have pessossion of the premises, or to change the conditions of the Lease after such expiration er the like netice be given by the lesses to the Lesser, of their intention to vacate the premises after such expiration; then it is hereby agreed that this Lease will be considered as extending and binding in all its previsions for one year after such expiration; and so to continue from year to year, until such notice be given by either party; previous to the e xpiration of such extended term.
