being in the City of Greenville State and County aforesaid and in the Sixth Ward, on what was formerly Judson St, now Wayne Street described as follows; beginning at an Ornt Pin on Wayne St So E. corner of 4th Taylor's lot there with said 4th Taylor, line N 19° 47' 20" from or less to front Pin, out Thru stone line with said Thru stone line N 4° 46' 0" more or less to front Pin then a S 18° 100' S & more or less to front Pin S 79° 52' W 11' S & more or less to front Pin S 13° 16' 8" E 100' S & more or less to front Pin on said Wayne St between S 80° 45' with Wayne St 100' S & more or less to beginning corner being at the west end line fourth of Plat recorded P.M.C. Office D. 1905 No. 16 page 83C. it is further agreed between S. J. Hunt his heirs and assigns that the said W. H. Hunt is to have the use of alley and hill between lot one & two said Alley and Hill from the date hereof joint property of the owners of lots 1 & 3 & 4

And W. H. Hunt do hereby bind W. H. Hunt, his Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. H. Hunt, his.

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
