Finlay all that piece of land, containing two and one-half acres, more or less, situated being and lying in the County and State aforesaid, on the Cedar Branch or Cedar's Bridge road, about two and one-half miles from Greenville (which is) six miles, and known as the Springfield with boundaries viz; beginning at a place 3X on the Middle side of said road said Springfield corner and running thence N.W. 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ft to an old pine 3X on the corner of middle line thence with said line, S 80 E, 172 ft to a tree 3X over and to the corner, then S 62 E, 8 1/2 ft off to a stone 3X on said line thence with south side of said street N 33 1/2 W 33 1/2 ft running 3X on said street thence S 10 E, 430 ft to a tree 3X on Cedar Branch road thence with said road along north side 3 1/2 ft to the beginning corner adjoining said Springfield corner, and leaving a part of three lots of Blocks No. 17, 18, 19, the late division being there.
