the County and State aforesaid, containing twenty two and one fourth (22 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) acres more or less, having the following metes and bounds, beginning on a stone 3 x 0 on road to Greenville Court House, thence S 65 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 8.70 to stone thence N 26 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 16.75 to stone 3 x 0 thence N 75 W 14.00 to a stone 3 x 0 thence N 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 3.00 to a stone on road, thence along said road N 87 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 3.60 to a red oak, (down) stake 3 x 1 thence along said road S 47 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 2.2 to a stone 3 x 0 on public road, thence down said road to beginning corner bounded by lands of J.
