(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peter F. Burton all that piece parcel and lot or tract of land lying, being and situate in the County and state aforesaid and on Middle Tyger River and in Highbush Township containing Twenty-five (25) acres more or less and having the following marks, bearings and distances, to-wit beginning on a stone 3 x 0. M. on Eastern Bank of Middle Tyger river thence S. 85 E. 1246 feet to a st. C. stump 3 x 0. M. thence S. 3. E. 1965 feet to a stone 3 x 0. M. thence S. 84 E. 891 feet to a stone 3 x 0. M. on Middle Tyger river, thence up meandering of the said river 1201 feet to the beginning corner, and adjoining lands of H. O. Moore A. & Howell and others.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Peter F. Burton his Heirs and Assigns forever.
