(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said D. Perry, Edwards, all that piece of land or tract of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville in the state aforesaid on Brushy Creek waters of Saluda river and hath the following bounds and marks; beginning at a stake 3x on the Air Line rail-road and running thence S 30° E 24.56 chains to stake 3x, 3x on Ballingers and Deters corner, thence S 83° E 10 chains to stake 3x with thence N 72° W 39.50 chains to the Air Line rail-road; thence with said rail-road S 60° W 26.88 chains to the beginning, containing fifty-four acres more or less adjoining lands of Farmer, Deep, and Ballinger.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said D. Perry Edwards, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said D. Perry Edwards, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
