(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. O. Boyd, his heirs and assigns forever

All that certain piece, parcel, and lot of land situate, lying and being in ward 5 of the City of Greenville and in the County and State aforesaid at the corner of Jenkins street and Green Avenue, Beginning at the intersection of said streets, and running thence N. 26 E. with Green Avenue fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence in a northerly direction perpendicular to said Green Avenue and parallel with said Jenkins Street something over one hundred and twenty two (22) feet to a stake on line of lot now owned by James Willis; thence in a South-westerly direction along with line of the lot of said James Willis, to said Jenkins Street; thence with said street to beginning corner, the front and rear lines of said lot on each fifty (50) feet in length, and the width about one hundred and twenty two (22) feet, the lot containing to me Two thousand and one hundred (2100) square feet more or less and is the same lot that was conveyed to me by W. Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
