(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ellen R. Arnold, all that piece, parcel and lot of land, in city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the west side of Rowley street, and known as lot #36, on a plat made by J. C. Lirine October 6, 1904 and also shown approximately on a plat made by J. N. Southern and recorded in Book 242, page 542 in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, beginning at an iron pin at corner of lot #34 and running thence S 20° 19' west, with Rowley street one hundred and three feet seven 1/2 inches (103 ft. 7 1/2 in) to an iron pin corner of lot #38; thence with line of said lot N. 69° 29' W. two hundred and ten (210) feet to an iron pin on twelve foot alley; thence with said alley N. 20° 19' E. one hundred and three feet seven 1/2 inches (103 ft. 7 1/2 in) to an iron pin; thence S. 69° 29' E. two hundred and ten (210) feet to the beginning corner.

Its President and Secretary, Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
