 sell and release unto the said O. E. Smith all that pieces parcel of land out of
 of my present house tract on the Rutherford road about 8
 miles north of Greenville City and having the following westerly and
 bounded, Beginning at rock above spring and running thence N.
 7° 7' 7.96 chains to stone 3 x n: thence N. 71 W. 16.00 chains to a stone 3 x n:
 thence N. 14 1/2 E. 6.50 chains to stone 3 x n: thence N. 75 1/2 W. 3.27 chains to
 stone; thence S. 14 1/2 W. 11.10 chains to stone 3 x o: thence S. 88 E. 14.70 to stone
 3 x o: thence S. 83 E. 4.50 c. to the Beginning corner containing fourteen and
 one quarter acres, more or less and also that other parcel and
 piece of land lying on the Rutherford road north of my house
