Office for Greenville County in book H.H.H. page 775, did authorize and empower Elizabeth F. Boyce to sell in their name convey by deed in parcels, certain lands, of which the lots hereinafter described is a part, NOW, Therefore, we Elizabeth F. Boyce, Frances W. Boyce, and Lucy G. Boyce of the District of Columbia being Heirs at law of James P. Boyce deceased,

in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, to El. Graham of the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said El. Graham all that piece of land and lots of land in Ward two in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville State of South Carolina and above particularly described in plan of "Boyce Addition," recorded in the office of R.M.C. Plan Book "A" page 90 and 91, Block 2, Lot 8 having the following metes and bounds: commencing at an iron fence south west corner of Mainly and Pettigru streets; thence S. 65° E. along Pettigru street one hundred fifty-two feet to an iron fence corner lot, 2, 7, and 8; thence N. 64° 45' E. One hundred fifty feet to an iron line on Mainly street; thence N. 15° 30' W. ~~slanting~~ feet to the beginning, bounded on the east by Mainly street, north Pettigru street, west by lot 1, and south by lot owned by Mary P. Agnew.

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
