Mrs. G. J. Deweyfield of said City and County and State
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
sell and release unto the said Mrs. G. J. Deweyfield her heirs and assigns

forever all that piece, parcel and lot of land in the City
of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the North-
west side of Bowley street, beginning at an iron pin on
said street three hundred and twenty-nine (329) feet
and four (4) inches from Stone Avenue, and running;
thence N. 69° 29' W. two hundred and ten (210) feet to an iron
pin on alley; thence with said alley S. 20° 19' W. Fifty-one (51)
feet and nine and three quarters (9 3/4) inches to corner
of lot sold by me to P. F. Walker; thence with Walker's
line S. 69° 29' E. two hundred and ten (210) feet to an
iron pin on Bowley street; thence with Bowley street
N. 20° 19' E. Fifty-one (51) feet and nine and three

and her Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
