H. Stansay of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Stansay all those parcels of land adjoining each other, situated lying and being in Saluda Township in Greenville County and its bounds about fifteen miles from Greenville City S. C. and on the Pickens road and on Concanal road containing in the aggregate Sixty-five (65) acres more or less. First two parcels containing in the aggregate twenty five (25) acres more or less being the lands which were conveyed to said J. D. Talley by L. C. Dickson by deed bearing date October 3rd 1892 and recorded in the R. M. C. office at Greenville S. C. in Deed Book A. A. 1 page 450 and is more particularly described therein. Second two parcels containing in the aggregate Forty (40) acres more or less being the lands which were conveyed to said J. D. Talley by L. F. Dill by deed bearing date March 28, 1899 and recorded in the R. M. C. office at Greenville, S. C. in Deed Book G. F. at page 549 and which said lands are more particularly described therein. The said lands herein mentioned and described are a part of the Barnaby lands, and for a particular description by metes and bounds, courses and distances reference to the said Deeds to J. D. Talley is hereby saved bounded by lands of R. F. Stroud, P. W. Bassell and New Liberty Church lands, and others.

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
