(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Dr. W. A. Ross, the real estate hereunder

mentioned and described, upon conditions that the said premises shall never be used for either mercantile or manufacturing purposes without the consent in writing of the Fork Shoals Cotton Mill its successors or assigns; in the event of such use or the erection of any building or buildings for such purposes, then the said premises shall immediately revert to the grantor its successors or assigns.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Oak Lawn Township, County and State of said adjoining lands of G. T. Sullivan, Fork Shoals, British Church and others, containing 5% acres, more or less, and hath the following metes and bounds: Beginning at Oak on Fork Shoals road (also Church corner); thence S 62 1/2 E 7.00 to stone x 3; thence N. 6 W. 11.10 to stone out aforesaid road; thence N. 83 1/2 W. 3.13 to R. corner, thence S 30. W. 3.10 to cedar 3 x out; thence S 27 W. 6.12 to Beginning corner

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
